## MORE INFORMATION

To activate Windows XP by using an unattended installation, add the following information to the Unattend.txt file:

- In the Unattended section, type:


## AutoActivate $=$ Yes

- Under the UserData section, type:


## ProductID = yourProductID

(Your Product ID is located on the Certificate of Authenticity (COA) sticker.)
Note Every Windows XP retail installation must have a unique Product ID for activation.
If the Internet connection is through a proxy server, specify the proxy settings in the Unattend.txt file:

- In the Unattended section, type:


## ActivateProxy=Proxy

- Type your computer's proxy settings in the Proxy section.
