Note Before the automatic activation of Windows XP can occur, you must first establish an Internet connection.

MORE INFORMATION

To activate Windows XP by using an unattended installation, add the following information to the Unattend.txt file:

• In the **Unattended** section, type:

AutoActivate = Yes

• Under the **UserData** section, type:

ProductID = *yourProductID*

(Your Product ID is located on the Certificate of Authenticity (COA) sticker.)

Note Every Windows XP retail installation must have a unique Product ID for activation.

If the Internet connection is through a proxy server, specify the proxy settings in the Unattend.txt file:

• In the **Unattended** section, type:

ActivateProxy=Proxy

• Type your computer's proxy settings in the **Proxy** section.
