To install Remote Desktop Web Connection



- 1. Open Add or Remove Programs in Control Panel.
- 2. Click Add/Remove Windows Components.
- 3. Click **Application Server**, and then click **Details**.
- 4. Select Internet Information Services, and then click Details.
- 5. In the **Subcomponents of Internet Information Services** list, select **World Wide Web Service**, and then click **Details**.
- 6. In the **Subcomponents of World Wide Web Service** list, click the **Remote Desktop Web Connection** check box. Click **OK**. click **OK** again, and then click **OK** a third time.
- 7. In the Windows Components wizard, click **Next**.
- 8. Verify that the RDP-Tcp connection is checked in the **Connection types:** box, and then click **Next** to begin the installation of the Remote Desktop Web Connection.

Notes

- You must be logged on as an administrator or a member of the Administrators group in order to complete this procedure. If your computer is connected to a network, network policy settings may also prevent you from completing this procedure.
- To open a Control Panel item, click **Start**, click **Control Panel**, and then click the appropriate icon.
